For pretty much a hundred years the Museum of Isle of Wight Geology was home to the Island's geology and fossil selections. On August 10th 2001 this was transformed along with the opening of Dinosaur Isle, an interactive museum which substituted the old museum. Dinosaur Isle offers the area and conveniences to accordingly exhibit and preserve the abundant geological collections. The new museum was designed by local designers in the shape of an enormous pterodactyl and is home to all kinds of things from showcases to rock re-constructions to full sized fleshed dinosaurs!

The museum offers an all-year education service for schools and other organizations, and a program of public walks at locations of geological and palaeontological focus. Associates of the Isle of Wight Philosophical Society initiated the undertakings to get started with the collections about two hundred years ago, and a lot has been added to improve the collections to this point. Scientific journals and publications have featured the Dinosaur Isle fossil collection widely.

The new museum exhibits more than one thousand of the finest fossils from the collections, and the dedicated museum workforce and volunteers have invested lots of time arranging the specimens for the new displays. You will find a highly insightful introductory display gallery that includes fossil remnants and geological records of the isle. Every guest is afforded an in depth walk back through time spanning the Ice Age to the Cretaceous era when dinosaurs still roamed the earth. This takes you to the large dinosaur gallery, which has exciting displays including authentic fossils, skeletal re-constructions, life sized fleshed replicas and a couple of animatronic dinosaurs.

Open all year long, Dinosaur Isle assures to be interesting, pleasurable and informative for every single visitor. Displays utilize ingenious illumination, visuals, sound, scents and animatronic technology to create a fantastic experience. Having a mission to be a national centre of excellence in the selection, conservation, exhibit and interpretation of the Island's dinosaurs and varied geological history, the Dinosaur Isle Museum in the Isle of Wight is amongst the favorite and well-liked destinations in this charming holiday vacation spot.
