The very next day my wife told her friends at work about installing our new wireless surveillance cameras. She logged on to show them the pictures and she could see in the background that the door to the shed in the back yard was open. She called to see if I had forgotten to shut it. As soon as I said no she saw the garage door go up and a man exiting carrying two of my brand new saws. The police were able to catch the guy just a few miles down the road. He had spotted us unloading the building equipment and snuck in the next day to try and rob us. Less than 24 hours and those cameras more than paid for themselves.
